Summary of Activities

- During first year orientation programmes for students and parents of UG and PG, separate sessions have been held to bring awareness on the measures implemented to

- All students were directed to fill an affidavit available at www.antiragging.in and to mail the ID generated by the site to the anti-ragging cell Convener to the mail id antiraggingce@staloysiuselt.edu.in
- Collaborative programmes with relevant stakeholders such as District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) on the legal aspects of ragging offences was conducted on 21st September 2023.
- In addition to making sure that CCTV cameras are operating properly, the college also enhanced monitoring mechanism throughout the campus and hostel with the help of faculty, Warden and Security staff.
- New contact information for the Anti-Ragging Cell members and UGC helpline were displayed at more common places in the campus so that students can quickly get in touch with them, if any need arises.


