Theoretical Component (4.8 Credits)

The practical component consists of 216 hours of hands-on training at AHMA Karyattukara, where participants will engage in Clinical Experience, Communication Skills, Positive Reinforcement, Crisis Management, Collaborative Work & Evidence-Based Practices
