### **Data Analysis and Visualization**

The student feedback from 2022–2023 provides valuable insights into the quality of education, infrastructure, and overall experience at St. Aloysius College. The feedback was analyzed using both qualitative and quantitative methods, focusing on aspects such as curriculum effectiveness, teaching quality, and student support services. For the quantitative data, two five/ten point rating scales were used—one to measure agreement and the other to gauge satisfaction. Percentages were calculated for each question, and the results were visualized through pie charts and bar graphs, making it easy to spot trends and identify areas for improvement

The analysis focuses on several key areas:

**Feedback on Curriculum**: This section evaluates how effectively the curriculum promotes holistic development, meets societal needs, and offers practical learning opportunities like internships and fieldwork.

Feedback on Teaching and Learning: This section assesses the effectiveness of teaching, faculty engagement in student development, and overall satisfaction with the learning environment.

Feedback on College Infrastructure and Facilities: This section evaluates the adequacy of campus facilities, including the library and canteen, as well as the availability of student support services.

The feedback analysis collected both quantitative and qualitative data from students, calculating average scores out of 5 across various categories. The results were organized into two main sections for clarity.

- 1. Feedback on Curriculum, Teaching, and Learning Process
- 2. Feedback on College Infrastructure, Facilities, and Student Support





### **Key Findings and Analysis**

### **Curriculum and Teaching:**

- Students generally agreed that the curriculum aids in holistic development (mean score: 3.8).
- 2 There was a need for more opportunities in practical experiences such as internships, with the lowest mean score being 3.04.
- The teaching quality was rated positively, with punctuality and fairness in assessments scoring over 4.0.

### **Infrastructure and Support**:

- Library resources and staff received positive feedback (mean score: 3.89 and 6.87 respectively).
- There was strong appreciation for eco-friendly campus initiatives (mean score: 8.11).

### 3. Teaching and Learning Support


- 1 Continued focus on teacher engagement, mentoring, and career guidance will foster better relationships between students and faculty.
- 2 Increasing the use of technology (ICT tools) in classrooms can enhance the learning experience.


### Conclusion

### Introduction



### Methodology



- **Teaching Resources:** The adequacy of teaching resources was rated 7.32, indicating that improvements in resource availability could enhance teaching effectiveness.







### **Analysis of College Infrastructure and Support Services:**

- Classroom and Lab Maintenance: The timely maintenance of these facilities was rated 7.27, showing satisfaction but suggesting room for improvement.
- Administrative Staff Support: This area received a high rating of 8.56, reflecting strong satisfaction with the support from administrative staff.
- Canteen and Washroom Cleanliness: Both areas received lower ratings, with the canteen's cleanliness at 6.34 and washrooms at 6.61, indicating the need for significant improvements.

### Key Strengths

### 1. Curriculum Clarity and Objectives:

- Faculty rated the clarity of course objectives highly with a mean score of 4.58, indicating strong alignment between course goals and faculty expectations.
- The **overall curriculum quality** was rated positively at **4.02**, showing satisfaction with the structure and relevance of the curriculum.

### 2. Professional Development:

- Support from management for faculty development programs received a high score of **8.38**, reflecting strong institutional backing for faculty growth.
- Faculty appreciated the freedom to implement innovative teaching techniques, as reflected in a score of 7.5.

### 3. Administrative Support:

The support from administrative staff was rated very positively with a mean score of **8.56**, highlighting the efficient and helpful nature of the administrative services provided to faculty.

### 4. Student-Centric Learning:

Faculty indicated satisfaction with the use of experiential and participatory learning methods in the curriculum, scoring 4.27, which supports active and engaging learning environments.

### Areas for Improvement

### 1. Balance Between Theory and Practice:

The balance between theory and practical application in the curriculum was rated at 3.67, suggesting a need for incorporating more hands-on learning experiences, projects, or internships to enhance practical skills.



### 2. Adequacy of Teaching Resources:

The score of 7.32 for teaching resources indicates that while generally adequate, there is still room for improvement in the availability and quality of resources provided for effective curriculum delivery.

### 3. Infrastructure Maintenance:

Timely maintenance of classrooms and laboratories was rated at 7.27, indicating that while maintenance is generally good, further attention to timely repairs and upgrades could enhance the teaching environment.


### 4. Cleanliness of Washrooms and Canteen:


