At St. Aloysius College, Elthuruth, Thrissur, we value the input of our stakeholders-students, parents, teachers, alumni, parents and employers-as it plays a vital role in our growth and development. Their feedback helps shape our academic programs while also improving key areas like infrastructure, student support, and community engagement.

This feedback is more than just an academic tool; it helps us create a better environment for all. Whether it's upgrading facilities, enhancing mentorship and career services, or expanding extracurricular opportunities, these insights guide our efforts to foster both academic excellence and personal growth across the campus.

Feedback Mechanism

Feedback Data Collection: At St. Aloysius College, the feedback process is designed to actively gather input from various stakeholders-students, teachers, alumni, parents and employers. The goal is to ensure the institution can continuously improve in areas such as curriculum, academic performance, and the overall learning environment. The feedback forms, structured with two key types of statements-statements on quality and statements of agreement-help gauge satisfaction and identify areas that need attention.

The Criterion 1 Head, in collaboration with the Feedback Committee, prepares different stakeholders feedback forms to ensure all important areas are covered. After the questionnaire is finalized, it is reviewed during a scheduled IQAC working group meeting, where any final



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adjustments are made before approval. Once approved, the feedback forms are shared with the respective departments through IQAC representatives, heads of departments, or course coordinators. Most of the data collection happens online, with the feedback forms distributed via WhatsApp groups to ensure easy communication with different stakeholders. This system allows the feedback to be gathered efficiently and shared with the right departments, enabling them to address concerns and make improvements where necessary.

Through this well-organized process, St. Aloysius College ensures that feedback is not just collected but effectively used to enhance both academic quality and the overall student experience

Feedback Analysis Report: The feedback data, stored in an Excel file, is shared with each department to review responses from different stakeholders on aspects like teaching, learning, infrastructure, facilities, and student support. Each department conducts its own analysis, creating visual representations to highlight key areas such as curriculum, academic performance, and the overall college environment.

A department-level report is then generated, summarizing the feedback from stakeholders. Departments may also include their own additional feedback data, ensuring a more comprehensive analysis that reflects their specific concerns.

Once the departmental feedback reports are finalized, they are submitted to the IQAC. The IQAC further analyzes the data, both quantitatively and qualitatively, using visual tools to present the findings. These reports are then compiled into a consolidated institutional feedback report, which highlights strengths and areas for improvement. This thorough analysis enables the college to address specific concerns and continuously improve the quality of education and overall experience for all stakeholders.

Feedback Action Taken Report: Based on the feedback collected and analyzed from various stakeholders, each department develops an action plan to address the concerns and areas for

improvement identified in the feedback. These actions may include modifications to the curriculum, enhancements in teaching methods, improvements in infrastructure, or better student support services.

The department prepares an Action Taken Report based on students' feedback, outlining the steps taken to address the issues raised. This report is then submitted to the IQAC, which consolidates all departmental reports into a comprehensive institutional action plan

The IQAC ensures that this action plan is communicated to the appropriate governing bodies, such as the university and college management, for review and approval. This systematic approach ensures that the feedback from stakeholders leads to meaningful changes, helping to improve the overall quality of education and services provided by the college.

Introduction

St. Aloysius College focuses on student success and satisfaction by creating an environment conducive to both academic and personal growth. The college regularly seeks student feedback to ensure its programs, facilities, and services meet changing needs. This feedback is crucial for continuous improvement, helping shape curriculum, policies, and services to better align with student aspirations and requirements. The college collects feedback on course relevance, creative learning, value system inclusion, and capacity building. Student feedback serves as a crucial tool for understanding their experiences and expectations, providing valuable insights into strengths and areas for improvement, particularly in curriculum, teaching quality, and campus facilities.

This engagement highlights the college's dedication to transparency, responsiveness, and accountability in creating a positive academic environment.

For the 2023–2024 academic year, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) conducted a detailed feedback questionnaire to collect student perspectives. This initiative is crucial for guiding the development of the college's educational programs, support services, and campus infrastructure. By incorporating student feedback into decision-making, the college aims to address current needs and anticipate future challenges in higher education.

Methodology

To enhance education quality and student experience, St. Aloysius College's Internal Quality Accurate Cell (IQAC) initiated a comprehensive student feedback process for the 2023–2024 accurate generic year. A dedicated feedback committee was established to create a google form,



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developed through careful discussions to address all key aspects of student life.

The student feedback was gathered across three main sections:

Basic Student Details

Criterion 1

This section gathered demographic information, such as students' academic backgrounds, to provide insights into the diversity of respondents and their experiences at the college.

Feedback on Curriculum, Teaching, and Learning Process

Students provided input on courses and teaching practices to evaluate curriculum alignment with industry trends and career preparation. Ratings on various aspects helped assess and improve the quality of academic programs.

Feedback on College Infrastructure, Facilities, and Student Support

This section assessed the quality of college facilities, such as the library and canteen, and student support services such as counselling services, mentorship programs and financial aid counseling. Student ratings are vital for improving these resources and enhancing the overall learning environment.

Rating Scales

To gather useful insights, students rated each aspect of their experience using the following scales, which were applied to curriculum, teaching and learning process, academic ambience and student support. The following were the two five-point rating scales used.

Agreement Scale

- 5-Strongly Agree
- 4-Agree
- 3-Not Sure
- 2-Disagree
- 1-Strongly Disagree.

Quality Scale

- 5-Excellent
- 4-Very Good
- Good





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2-Average

1-Needs Improvement.

A total of 1,040 students, including Under Graduates, Post Graduates, and Ph.D. candidates, took part in the online feedback. Faculty and department heads encouraged widespread participation and honest feedback.

The feedback collected both quantitative and qualitative provides essential insights into the effectiveness of the college's programs and services. This will aid our college in enhancing the educational experience for current and future students, ensuring a high-quality, supportive academic environment.

Data Analysis and Visualization

The 2023–2024 student feedback offers valuable insights into education quality, infrastructure, and overall experience at St. Aloysius College. The feedback has been analyzed through qualitative and quantitative methods, it covers curriculum effectiveness, teaching quality, and student support services. Quantitative feedback utilized a five-point rating scale to express agreement or satisfaction.

For each feedback question, response percentages were calculated and visualized using pie charts and bar graphs. These visualizations offer a clear depiction of the data, highlighting trends and areas needing improvement.

The analysis focuses on several key areas

Feedback on Curriculum: This section evaluates how effectively the curriculum promotes holistic development, meets societal needs, and offers practical learning opportunities like internships and fieldwork.

Feedback on Teaching and Learning: This section assesses the effectiveness of teaching, faculty engagement in student development, and overall satisfaction with the learning environment.

Feedback on College Infrastructure and Facilities: This section evaluates the adequacy of campus facilities, including the library and canteen, as well as the availability of student support





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Student Recommendation: This section assesses whether students would recommend the college to others, indicating their overall satisfaction with their educational experience. The insights gained from this analysis will inform the college's strategic decisions for continuous improvement, ensuring it remains responsive to student needs while upholding high educational standards

The feedback analysis collected both quantitative and qualitative data from students,

calculating average scores across various categories. The findings were divided into two main sections, with the results summarized in a table, followed by visual representations and the corresponding analysis report.

that.



Most students believe that the curriculum is doing a good job in helping with their holistic development. In fact, 53% agreed with the statement, and another 8.7% strongly agreed. However, about 31% of students weren't sure, which suggests that while many feel positive about the curriculum's impact, there's room to make the benefits clearer to all students. Overall, the feedback shows that St. Aloysius College is on the right track when it comes to helping students grow in more ways than just academically.

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

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

The majority of students feel that the curriculum provides ample opportunities for fieldwork and internships, with 48.1% agreeing and 14.3% strongly agreeing. However, a significant number of students (25.6%) were unsure about the availability of these opportunities, which may indicate a need for better communication or more structured access to practical experiences. Addressing these concerns can help ensure that all students are able to take advantage of experiential learning opportunities as part of their education





Most students believe that the syllabus is well-organized, with 54.8% agreeing and 12.3% strongly agreeing. However, nearly a quarter of students (24.6%) were unsure, which suggests that some syllabi might not be as clear or consistent across courses. By making sure all syllabi are detailed and provide clear guidance, the college can help ensure that students feel more confident about the structure and objectives of their courses.

Relevance of the Curriculum to Real-World Situations





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



A positive student-teacher relationship can greatly influence the learning experience. This question focuses on how students perceive their relationship with instructors and the level of support they receive from them.





An effective curriculum can spark a desire for further learning. This question examines whether the coursework at St. Aloysius College has inspired students to consider pursuing higher education.







Overall Analysis of Student Feedback on Curriculum, Teaching and Learning

Process

The feedback collected from students provides valuable insights into their perceptions of the curriculum and teaching practices at St. Aloysius College. The key aspects evaluated in this section include the relevance of the curriculum, the quality of teaching, and opportunities for experiential learning. The responses were analyzed across various metrics, such as how well the the curriculum prepares students for real-world situations, the relationship between students and

teachers, and the overall quality of the learning process.

Holistic and Comprehensive Development

Over 60% of students agreed that the curriculum helps in their overall personal development, while around 31% were unsure. This suggests that the curriculum is largely successful but could benefit from clearer communication on how it supports holistic development.

Catering to Societal Needs

Most students (around 64%) agreed that the curriculum caters to the diverse needs of society. However, a portion of students (29%) were unsure, indicating potential for improvement in showcasing how the curriculum addresses societal challenges.

Opportunities for Fieldwork and Internships

Nearly 62% of students felt that the curriculum offers ample opportunities for practical experiences, such as internships and fieldwork, but 26% were unsure. There is room for the college to enhance its communication about available opportunities or increase access to experiential learning.

Teacher Involvement in Enhancing Subject Knowledge

More than 65% of students agreed or strongly agreed that teachers were effective in enhancing their subject knowledge. However, about 25% of students were uncertain, suggesting some variation in teaching practices across courses.

Student-Teacher Relationship

A strong 66.6% of students reported having positive relationships with their teachers, though 22% were unsure. Building more consistent teacher-student relationships across departments could further enhance the student experience.

Professional Development Impact

Almost 61% of students agreed that the curriculum has positively impacted their professional development, although around 28% were uncertain. Strengthening the connection between academic content and career readiness might address this uncertainty.

Syllabus Organization

e than 67% of students felt that their syllabi were well-organized and appropriate for their

courses. Still, 24% of students were unsure, which points to an opportunity for more consistent syllabus structure across courses.

Curriculum Relevance to Real-World Situations

Around 61% of students agreed that the curriculum is relevant to real-world scenarios. However, nearly 30% were unsure, indicating a need for more practical, real-world applications within the curriculum.

Interest in Higher Studies

Nearly 60% of students said that the curriculum sparked an interest in pursuing further studies, though 30% remained uncertain. More encouragement toward higher education pathways may help inspire students further.

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
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Library Facilities

Libraries play an essential role in supporting students' academic success by providing access to resources, study spaces, and research tools. This question evaluates how students perceive the adequacy and accessibility of library facilities at the college.



Response Distribution

- Agree : 55.3%
- Not Sure : 21.5%
- Strongly Agree : 12.1%
- Disagree : 7.8%
- Strongly Disagree : 3.3%

The majority of students, with 67.4% (combined "Agree" and "Strongly Agree"), feel positively about the library facilities. However, a notable percentage (21.5%) are unsure, indicating potential areas for improvement in terms of awareness or communication about library services. A smaller portion of students (11.1%) expressed dissatisfaction, suggesting room for enhancing accessibility, availability of resources, or physical study spaces.

ern education relies heavily on technology, and well-equipped computer labs are critical for







Response Distribution

- Agree: 48.9%
- Not Sure: 27.4%
- Strongly Agree: 10.6%
- Disagree: 8.9%
- Strongly Disagree: 4.2%

The responses show that 59.5% of students (combined "Agree" and "Strongly Agree") are satisfied with the IT and computer lab facilities. However, a significant percentage of students are either unsure (27.4%) or dissatisfied (13.1%), pointing to possible challenges in equipment availability, lab maintenance, or accessibility. Addressing these concerns could enhance the overall student experience.

Classroom Infrastructure




















Conclusion



- **2. Satisfaction with academic environment (Mean: 4.084):** There is overall satisfaction with the academic environment, though there may still be room for improvement.
- **3.** Child's access to college (Mean: 4.040): The respondents rate their child's access to the college quite positively, indicating that transportation, accessibility, or entry processes are perceived as adequate.
- **4. Promotion of inclusive education (Mean: 4.134):** The college is seen as promoting inclusive education, reflecting a commitment to diversity and ensuring that various student needs are met.
- **5. Campus safety (Mean: 4.287):** Parents feel confident about the safety of the campus environment, which is crucial for student well-being and peace of mind.

Information about attendance and academic activities (Mean: 4.468): There is a high level of satisfaction with the communication regarding attendance and academic activities, suggesting strong transparency between the college and parents.

7. Environment conducive to academic and social activities (Mean: 4.134): The campus is viewed as fostering a positive environment for both academic learning and social engagement, supporting holistic student development.

- 8. Curriculum influence on engagement (Mean: 3.955): Parents have a slightly lower perception of how well the curriculum influences their child's interest and engagement, indicating an area that may require attention for better alignment with student interests.
- **9. Infrastructure to support curriculum (Mean: 4.025):** The college's infrastructure is seen as adequate for supporting the curriculum, though not outstanding, signaling that while functional, some improvements could be made.
- **10. Holistic development (Mean: 3.564)**: This score is the lowest, suggesting concerns about whether the program truly promotes holistic development, indicating a potential gap in addressing students' broader development needs beyond academics.
- **11. Teacher involvement in child's learning (Mean: 4.213):** Parents generally believe that teachers are actively involved in their child's learning and development, suggesting effective teaching practices and dedication.
- **12.** Curriculum preparation for future goals (Mean: 3.955): There is a neutral to slightly positive view on how well the curriculum prepares students for future educational or career goals, indicating that more effort may be needed to enhance this aspect.
- **13. Parental information on student activities (Mean: 4.287):** Parents feel well-informed about student-related activities, showing strong communication from the school.
- 14. Teacher addressing individual needs (Mean: 4.054): Teachers are perceived as adequately addressing students' individual needs, though there may still be room for more personalized support.
- **15.** Course potential to enhance life skills and employability (Mean: 3.842): This score suggests some skepticism about the course's ability to enhance life skills and employability, hinting at a need for stronger focus in these areas.

16. Teacher communication during meetings (Mean: 4.109): Teacher communication during meetings is rated positively, reflecting effective dialogue and exchange of feedback metween teachers and parents.

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

Key Insights





The pie chart in the image shows the distribution of responses to the statement: "The college encourages students who excel in every aspect." The responses are divided into five categories:


