

Mechanism

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


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Key Findings




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Key Findings

Areas for Improvement

2. Effectiveness of Career Services

3. Coverage of Emerging Technologies

Employers expect graduates to be familiar with advanced resources that are common in their industries.

5. Entrepreneurial Skills Development

• Rating: 3.87/5

While graduates are moderately prepared in terms of employable and entrepreneurial skills, further opportunities could be provided to develop these competencies. Incorporating more entrepreneurial-focused programs, workshops, or mentorship opportunities could encourage students to develop innovative and self-driven career paths.

6. Support Services (Counseling, Mentoring)

• Rating: 3.52/5

Support services, including counseling and mentoring, could be enhanced to ensure students have the guidance and support they need for personal and professional development. Strengthening these services would contribute to better student well-being and career readiness.
