1. Introduction

This is a year which has stretched us to our limits, a year which has taught us things beyond our worst nightmares, and, better dreams, even. We have learned that things can go tough, and, we have also learned, tough things can be got over.

It is my proud privilege to present before you the annual college report of St. Aloysius College during the academic year 2020-21.

This year has taken us through a series of uncertainties. Yet we have come up with innumerable contributions, individual and collective; to academia, and, to society. I take this opportunity to thank the management, staff, well-wishers and students for your kind cooperation and valuable contributions to St. Aloysius College.

In Spite of the realities of restricted mobility and the impossibility of bringing students to the campus, we have tried our level best to reach out to them. In this regard, I congratulate our teaching and administrative staff for their selfless efforts to acclimatize themselves to the new education system without compromising on quality. As I make this statement, I hold with me the Annual Report of the academic year 2020-2021 that declares the institution's resolute spirit to serve during this pandemic-stricken period.

2. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell

On 15 November 2019 we were assessed for the third stage accreditation process of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council and St. Aloysius College was accredited with CGPA of 2.97 at B++ grade. As such, we stand tall on our continual efforts for excellence through the past and keep working hard.

The IQAC of St. Aloysius has been an instrument for total quality management. It promotes quality initiatives of various departments for the enhancement and sustenance of excellence. At present Shri. Melvin Luke George is the Co-Ordinator of the IQAC.



3. Teaching and Learning during the Pandemic Times

The Pandemic Times were difficult times when the world stood paralysed. The academic work had to be paused at times and restored with all obstacles around. As we shifted from the real world to the virtual one, at least in terms of class room teaching, there were many hurdles. Sporadic digital connectivity was a big issue, and lack of human connectivity, a bigger one. Economic and gender divide stretched its gap wider and we also underwent psychological stress as we were homebound for longer times than usual. Yet St. Aloysius worked as a team, we tried our level best. As we started our online classes in June, we searched out students who found it difficult to access classes, and Departments, teachers and students found ways to help them out, sometimes through sponsorships, and, sometimes from their own pockets. Still students missed social life and faced multiple health issues due to long screen times and found it tiresome to sit before the monito. departments organised various co-curricular activities and webinars to tide over the tedium of online learning. Audio, Video, PPT, and notes were shared through whatsapp, emails, etc. moreover the faculty reached out individually to students to sort out issues when they had some.

3.1. Innovations in Teaching

The faculty visibly improved their ICT skills during the period. Classes were uploaded through platforms like Google classroom, Edmodo, etc., online classes were conducted through Webex, Zoom and Google Meet, etc., tests were conducted using Google Forms, Bookwidge, etc., classes were recorded using screen recorders like Xrecorder, Active Presenter, OBS Studio, etc. We also experimented with our own digital platform MeetXp. Many departments started their YouTube Channels and opened their Facebook Pages to help students get connected and to disseminate relevant information.

3.2 Student Progress: Results

One of the main benchmarks of an institution's quality is the progress of its students. The university Exam Results 2020 were not bad for St. Aloysius.
