4) Aloysian Center for Kole Wetland Studies and Research

The center was inaugurated by Shri. K Rajan, Honorable Minister for Revenue, Government of Kerala in the month of 2nd October 2023. The centre's mission is to promote the conservation, awareness and sustainable development of the Kole wetlands in Kerala. The Kole Wetland Centre would provide a number of benefits to the local community and to the environment. 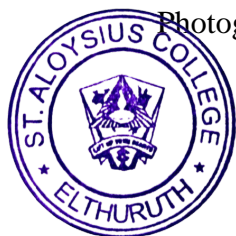
3. ALCHEMISTA
