All activities for the second day

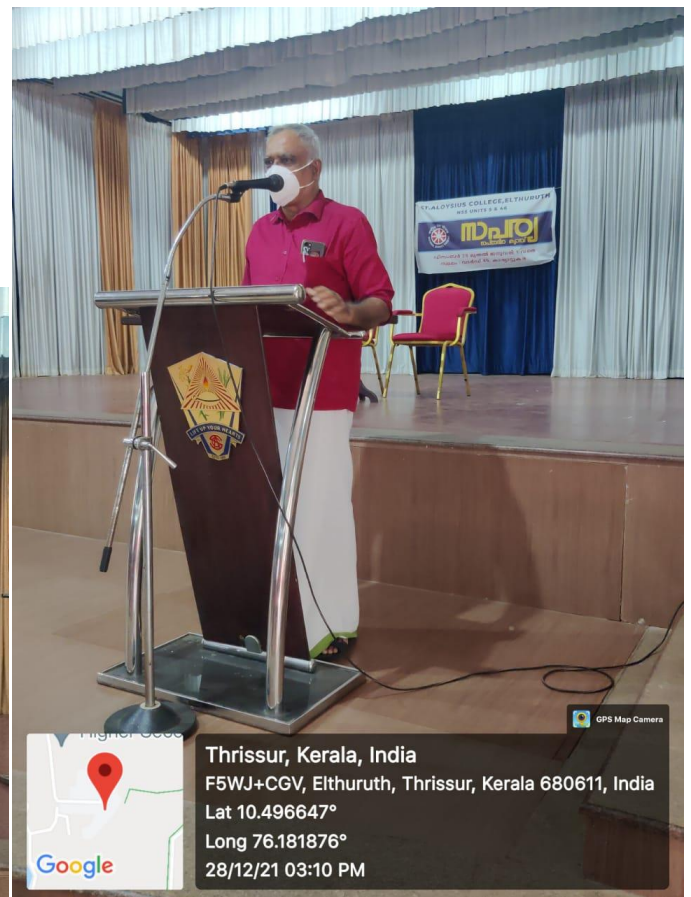

Day 3 - 28/12/2021

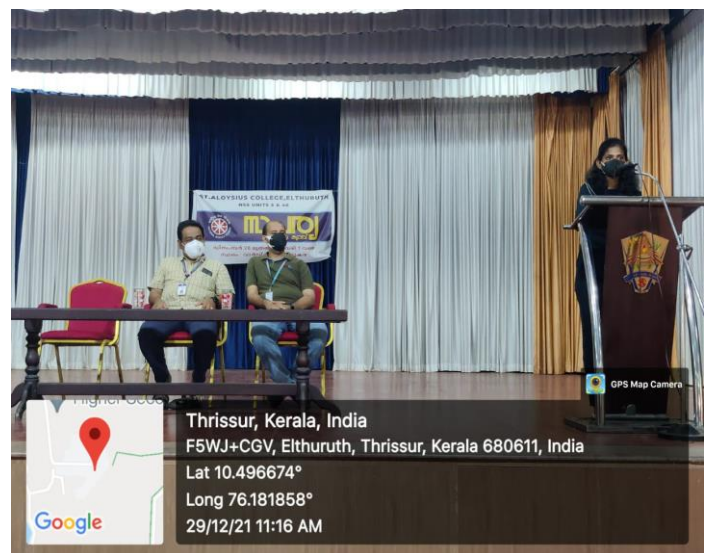
