International Day against Drug Abuse 2023






World Environment Day 2023

The programme lasted till 5.00 PM.










Rain Walk (Mazha Nadatham) 2023






World Yoga Day Celebrations 2023








World Day for International Justice 2023




NSS Meeting 2023




